Re: Dr. Feng Gao

This is a follow-up to our telephone conversation of December 3, 1992. Your client, our patient, Dr. Feng Gao, is currently being treated with medication for a psychiatric disorder. He was admitted under the Mental Health Act - copies of the two Medical Certificates are enclosed.

As I explained on the telephone, the health of Dr. Gao is, and will continue to be, our primary concern. This, of course, includes assessment of the patient for danger to himself or others. Once his treatment is established to the point where it can be continued as an outpatient, he will be discharged.

We must, of course, discharge him if a Review Panel or other legally constituted body orders his discharge irrespective of our perceptions regarding his readiness for community care. Dr. Gao has been made aware of his rights to appeal the Medical Certificates to the Review Panel and our obligation to him as our patient.

I hope this answers your questions and please do not hesitate to contact me again as necessary.
