Still unsuccessful in finding employment & told officially that his mother's visitor's visa won't be renewed therefore plans to go to her to Mainland China around Dec 8/9 & return 2-4 weeks later, to Ontario, where he hopes to be more successful at finding employment. Will give up his basement suite & friends of his mother will store his possessions, including his car if he isn't successful in selling it before he leaves. Stalts Fired Hitchcock will give him a formal letter authorizing him to leave B.C. in the event he encounters difficulty w/ customs officials, & he'll bring a copy to next appt. Continues to be defensive when discuss past behaviors but does acknowledge that this was a very stressful time in his life. If mother returns to China Mr. GAO will remain in Canada and wait for his peace bonds to expire and then look for employment opportunities in the U.S. & Canada. Finances remain to be difficult for him however he states that he is able to cope. Denies feeling anxious or depressed at present.
